Atempo Live Navigator (ALN)



What is a Migration?

A migration is the term used to describe copying or moving critical data from one server to another, as well as configuring that target server to replace the first.

What Should You Avoid During Migrations?

Avoid the following during migrations:

- Avoid scheduling a move immediately before a critical period for your business.
- Migrations should generally be performed during off-hours or times when a minimal amount of business is expected.
- Avoid starting a migration until the exploration period is complete.
- Notify staff outside of the migration team about the migration.



5 Step Migration Plan For Atempo

Step 1: Stop all the Atempo services and disable them. Go to Services Tab and check the following services:

- ADDefault
- Bonjour
- FlexLM

Note: Please do not forget to disable the services.

How can I disable Windows Services?

- 1. Open a Windows Run Dialog (Win + R).
- 2. Type in services.msc
- 3. Right-click on the service and select Properties.
- 4. Click on the Stop button (if the service is running).
- 5. Change the Startup type to Disabled.
- 6. Click on OK.



Step 2: Copy all the data from the old server to a new server.

Step 3: Install the ALN setup file on the new server. (Please make sure you install the same version file on the new server).

Step 4: Map all old data to the new server.

Step 5: Change HDD partition name on server (Drive partition name should be same as the old server).

Note: Complete migration process takes up to 2 days or more. It depends on the ALN repository data size.
